

SULLY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
FEBRUARY 3, 2026

The Board of Sully County Commissioners held their regular scheduled mtg on Tues, February 3, 2026. Chairman Fanger called the mtg to order at 7:30 am. Other members present: Greg Yackley, William Floyd & Jerry Richards. Absent: Caleb Shepherd. Also, present were Sheila Ring, Emily Sovell, Kyle Beach & JJ Schall.

ADOPT AGENDA: Motion by Richards, second by Yackley to adopt the agenda. Motion carried 4-0. Absent: Shepherd.

PUBLIC COMMENT: No one was present for public comment.

MINUTES: Motion by Floyd, second by Yackley to approve minutes from the Bd of Commission mtg held on January 6th. Motion carried 4-0. Absent: Shepherd.

COMBINED ELECTION AGREEMENT: Motion by Yackley, second by Richards to approve agreement between City of Onida, Agar-Blunt-Onida School & Sully County for the 2026 Election year. Motion carried 4-0. Absent: Shepherd.

CPI: Aud Lamb informed Bd that CPI for 2026 pay 2027 has been set at 2.5%.

PROBATION INCREASES: Aud Lamb informed Bd that Marti Arbach will receive an \$.85/hr increase on February 4th & Becky Amio will receive an \$.85/hr increase on February 11th following their 6-month probation periods.

OPERATING TRANSFER: Motion by Richards, second by Floyd, to approve a \$500,000.00 operating transfer from the General Fund to Road & Bridge Fund. Motion carried 4-0. Absent: Shepherd.

COMMUNITY ACCESS GRANT: Bd received ltr from SD Dept of Transportation stating Sully County was not awarded a Community Access Grant.

OUTSIDE OF DEADWOOD GRANT: Aud Lamb informed Bd that grant funds have not been awarded yet for January 2026, grant period.

MEETING CAMERA/AUDIO: Discussion was held. Motion to table until March mtg by Yackley, second by Richards. Motion carried 3-1 with Fanger voting nay. Absent: Shepherd.

WEED & PEST PURCHASE REQUEST: Motion by Yackley, second by Floyd to approve chemical purchase request in the amount of \$16,667.00. Motion carried 4-0. Absent: Shepherd.

WEED & PEST CONTRACT SPRAYER BID: There was one bid received from Mid-Dakota Vegetation at \$89.00/hr Broadcast Spray & \$65.00/hr for pickups, \$50.00/hr for UTV/ATV to Spot Spray. Motion by Richards, second by Yackley to accept bid received from Mid Dakota Vegetation. Motion carried 4-0. Absent: Shepherd.

BRIDGE REINSPECTION RESOLUTION: Motion by Floyd, second by Richards to approve resolution. Motion carried 4-0. Absent: Shepherd.

BRIDGE REINSPECTION
PROGRAM RESOLUTION

FOR USE WITH SDDOT RETAINER CONTRACTS

WHEREAS, 23 CFR 650 Subpart C, requires initial inspection of all bridges and reinspection at intervals not to exceed two years with the exception of reinforced concrete box culverts that meet specific criteria. These culverts are reinspected at intervals not to exceed four years.

THEREFORE, Sully County is desirous of participating in the Bridge Inspection Program.

The County requests SDDOT to hire Brosz Engineering (Consulting Engineers) for the inspection work. SDDOT will secure federal approvals, make payments to the Consulting Engineer for inspection services rendered, and bill the County for 20% of the cost. The County will be responsible for the required 20% matching funds.

CLOSURE OF BRIDGE 60-392-230: Following review of bridge which is located on a "no maintenance" road additional signage marking bridge as impassable will be posted. Bd will re-evaluate road & bridge closure in the future.

SD DEPT OF TRANSPORTATION OVERWEIGHT ENFORCEMENT: SDDOT sent ltr stating STBGP Funds could be withheld if overweight enforcement is not followed per statute. Bd encouraged States Attny to avoid plea bargaining on overweight trucks & States Attny agreed to be mindful when prosecuting.

4-H ANNUAL REVIEW: Kyle Beach from SDSU reviewed results of annual survey with Bd.

SULLY LAKE CATTLE GUARD: Discussion was held on relocating & replacing cattle guard at Sully Lake. Item will placed on March agenda & ltr will be sent to leasee inviting attendance to discuss issue.

GRAVEL & CULVERT BID LETTING: Bid notices will be published with a bid opening date of March 3rd.

LOAD LIMITS: Load limits will be placed no later than March 1st depending on weather.

WATER LINE EASEMENT: Hwy Supt Schall received a water line easement from Earl Fanger to bore under road for

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Mid-Dakota Rural Water access.

SURPLUS HWY DEPT PICKUP: Hwy Supt Schall informed Bd that the pickup needs a new engine. Motion by Yackley, second by Floyd to surplus as junk the 1999 Ford F150 Supercab pickup. Motion carried 4-0. Absent: Shepherd.

HWY DEP PURCHASE REQUESTS: Motion by Yackley, second by Richards to approve request for mobilization of \$500.00 & \$450.00 per hole boring at Sully Lake gravel pit by Kyle Falkenhagen. Motion carried 4-0. Absent: Shepherd. Motion by Richards, second by Yackley to approve the purchase of 2026 13' Road Groomer at a cost of \$18,700.00. Motion carried 4-0. Absent: Shepherd. Motion by Floyd, second by Fanger to approve the purchase of ½ load of Mastik material at an approximate cost of \$14,000.00 & machine rental of approximately \$4,000.00. Motion carried 4-0. Absent: Shepherd. Motion by Yackley, second by Fanger to approve purchase request of asphalt/gravel mix from Logan Electric at a rate of \$22.00/ton to use on highway shoulders west of Onida & Agar. Motion carried 3-0. Abstain: Richards Absent: Shepherd. Motion by Yackley, second by Floyd to approve hwy digout & patching by Jensen Rock & Sand for \$100,000.00 west of Onida, \$50,000.00 west of Agar & \$50,000.00 east of Agar if work will be completed prior to microseal project. Motion carried 4-0. Absent: Shepherd.

HWY DEPT: Hwy Supt Schall discussed county wide sign project, culvert lining, & updated Bd on reprs made to motorgraders.

BUILDING PURCHASE REQUEST: Motion by Richards, second by Yackley to approve hire of TruGreen for lawn spraying at a reduced rate of \$2,275.62. Motion carried 4-0. Absent: Shepherd.

DOE UPDATE: DOE Arbach informed Bd that a MH located on Parcel #855 has not ever been assessed. Correction has been made for 2026 assessment. There are also 2 additional structures that will be assessed this spring on same parcel.




ADJOURNMENT: There being no further business, Chairman Fanger declared the mtg adjourned.
