

SULLY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
AUGUST 4, 2026

The Board of Sully County Commissioners held their regular scheduled mtg on Tues, August 4, 2026. Chairman Fanger called the mtg to order at 7:30 am. Other members present: Greg Yackley, William Floyd & Jerry Richards. Absent: Caleb Shepherd. Also, present were Sheila Ring, Bill Stahl, Curt Olson, Curt Mundt, Kyle Kurth, Emily Sovell & JJ Schall.

ADOPT AGENDA: Motion by Floyd, second by Richards to adopt the agenda. Motion carried 4-0. Absent: Shepherd
Comr Shepherd arrived at 7:33 am

PUBLIC COMMENT: Curt Mundt gave input on 176th Street east of Agar.

MINUTES: Motion by Shepherd, second by Yackley to approve minutes from the Bd of Commission mtg held on July 30th. Unanimous vote aye.

PAUL NELSON FARM HUNTING PRESERVE RENEWAL: Motion by Shepherd, second by Floyd to approve renewal application. Unanimous vote aye.

OUTSIDE OF DEADWOOD GRANT: Motion by Richards, second by Yackley to accept Outside of Deadwood Grant in the amount of \$7,500.00 for reprs to the Courthouse. Unanimous vote aye.

COURTHOUSE PURCHASE REQUEST: Motion by Shepherd, second by Yackley to accept the quote from Mid-Continental Restoration in the amount of \$36,073.00 for tuckpointing the southeast elevation & repairing the front steps & landing of the bldg. Unanimous vote aye.

CAPITAL AREA COUNSELING AGREEMENT: Motion by Richards, second by Yackley to approve the distribution of \$2,500.00 from the Opioid Settlement Fund to Capital Area Counseling. Unanimous vote aye.

SHERIFF'S OFFICE VEHICLE USE AGREEMENT: Motion by Floyd, second by Richards to approve agreement with the Onida Fire Department for use of the backup vehicle. Unanimous vote aye.

SD GAME, FISH & PARKS AGREEMENT #2027-59-02: Motion by Floyd, second by Yackley to approve 50/50 cost share agreement up to \$20,000.00 on .69 mile of Cow Creek Road from Spring Creek Place to Cow Creek Recreation Area for 2027. Unanimous vote aye.

SD GAME, FISH & PARKS AGREEMENT #2027-59-01: Motion by Floyd, second by Fanger to deny cost share agreement on .75 mile of Cow Creek Road to Outpost Lodge. Unanimous vote aye.

LEGAL MATTERS: State's Attny Sovell discussed legal matters with Bd.

OPERATING TRANSFER: Motion by Floyd, second by Richards to approve operating transfers to the Road & Bridge Fund in the amount of \$346,804.00, 911 in the amount of \$20,697.00 & Emergency Management in the amount of \$12,159.00. Unanimous vote aye.

HWY DEPT: Hwy Supt Schall discussed roads, vacation & equipment reprs with Bd.

HWY DEPT PURCHASE REQUEST: Motion by Yackley, second by Floyd to approve hwy reprs on 176th & 185th Streets west of Onida & Agar by Morris Inc at an approximate cost of \$50,000.00.

305th AVENUE PROJECT: Kyle Kurth from Brosz Engineering provided cost estimates to widen road & shave hill from 186th Street to ½ mile south. Bd discussed possible bid letting in late October.

2025 HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT: Sheriff Dep Olson informed Bd that Sheriff's Office received a 2025 Homeland Security Grant in the amount of \$17,008.92 towards the \$20,005.00 purchase of 3 mobile laptop computers. Motion by Shepherd, second by Richards to approve grant & allow purchase. Unanimous vote aye.

PRE-DISASTER HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN: Emergency Mgr Olson updated Bd on plan. He expects to see a revised plan in the next few weeks.

SPEED REDUCTION REQUEST: Curt Olson requested speed limit reduction from 55 mph to 35 mph on 186th Street going west 1 mile, ¾ mile 303rd Avenue heading north, ½ mile Airport Bypass Road going west and 1.25 miles going north to 185th Street. Motion by Shepherd, second by Yackley to approve request & instruct Aud Lamb to schedule readings & hearing on the Amended Ordinance. Roll Call Vote – Shepherd-aye, Fanger-nay, Yackley-aye, Richards-aye, Floyd-nay. Motion carried 3-2.

PROVISIONAL BUDGET REVIEW: Bd made adjustments to the projected 2027 Provisional Budget.

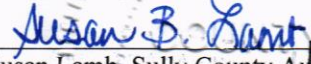
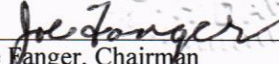
